- 3. Demonstrate how to judge good bows and arrows and know the names of their parts.
- 4. Demonstrate stringing and un-stringing a bow or know three methods of stringing a bow.
- 5. What does "weight" mean as applied to bows?
- 6. Show how to care for a bow when in use and how to store them properly.
- 7. Serve a string and show how to set it on a bow with the timber hitch.
- 8. Demonstrate the correct way of pulling an arrow from the target, and picking it up from the ground.
- 9. Demonstrate the correct stance used for shooting.
- 10. Be able to shoot a round at a target at a distance of 20 feet.
- 11. Learn three archery terms.
